

Bursary Information

RE: UALab Level 4 Foundation Diploma

The City & Guilds of London Art School is an independent art institution with a charitable status. We aim to support talented students in need of financial support to develop and improve their skills in the fields of Stone and Wood carving, Conservation and Fine Art. Limited funds are available to a Foundation student. The funds for bursaries in general are raised by the Art School and they are donations we receive from various benefactors which are increasingly hard to obtain and are restricted to those courses above mentioned. The Art School therefore works really hard to keep and raise money from private individuals, trust funds etc, in order to provide bursaries towards fees to some of our students who might not otherwise be able to do so otherwise.

Eligibility – The Art School's Foundation bursary:

- Is for a student who has been accepted to the Foundation course in our Art School and are unable to finance their studies in full;
- If approved, could provide for around £3,500* towards course fees (this year £5,000 was allocated, the maximum amount ever allocated to a Foundation student – however this is adjusted yearly and approved directly by our benefactor/s)
- Is revised termly and the Art School has the full right to withdraw any decision at any time if the beneficiary does not perform at a satisfactory level;
- Is aimed mainly to help students from Great Britain, Northern Ireland and the EU zone, and asylum seekers;
- Applicants should not be more than 26 years of age;
- Their household income should not exceed 26k (you must provide evidence);
- We haven't specified a deadline but I strongly advise the applicant to submit their bursary application (together with all the documents required) as soon as they receive an offer letter to the Foundation course.

*The students must be able to show they are able to pay the remainder of the fees. Please note that it is of great importance that the bursary funds are used in a way that will effectively support our students and maintain our benefactors satisfied.

Please note students on our Foundation Course are **not eligible** for fee subsidy by the Local Education Authority or Student Loan Company.
